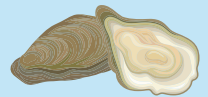

A service charge is usually included in the bill and so tipping is not expected

Cost of living & travel in Copenhagen



- Standard city one-way bus ticket: 24 DKK
- Daily (24hr) pass for all transport: 419 DKK
- Taxi fare: 49 DKK (initial charge); 12 DKK (per km)



- Standard pint of beer: 45 – 50 DKK
- 3-course meal for 2 people: 600 – 700 DKK



- Typical hotel for 2 adults: 1015 DKK (per night)
- Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment: 10,300 – 10,600 DKK (per month)



- Doctor's visit: 546 DKK

Costs are based on average in Copenhagen, Denmark in July 2021; costs will vary from region to region.
