Cost of living & travel in Kraków



- **Standard city one-way bus ticket:** 3.50 – 5 PLN
- **Monthly transport pass:** 95 – 110 PLN
- **Taxi fare:** 6 PLN (initial charge); 1.80 PLN (per km)



- **Standard pint of beer:** 11 PLN
- **3-course meal for 2 people:** 120 - 150 PLN



- **Typical hotel for 2 adults:** 70 – 150 PLN (per night)
- **Average rent for 1-bedroom apartment:** 2,500 – 3,400 PLN (per month)



- **Doctor's visit:** 120 PLN (15 minutes)
